

Queensland Museum *SparkLab* Sciencentre Competition

Terms and Conditions – August 2021

1. By entering this promotion, you accept these Terms and Conditions.
2. Instructions and information on how to enter this promotion for part of these Terms and Conditions.
3. “**Competition**” is a class visit to *SparkLab*, Sciencentre.
4. The promoter is Queensland Museum (ABN 91 522 611 802) of Corner Grey and Melbourne Streets, South Brisbane, Queensland, 4101 (“**Promoter**”).

Eligible entrants

5. To be eligible to enter this promotion, you must be an Australian resident over the age of 18 years old employed at an eligible school. Directors, management and employees of the Promoter and their immediate families, and any other person or employee of any agency connected with administering this promotion, are not eligible to enter this promotion. **Immediate family** means spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, stepparent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or first cousin.
6. Eligible schools are those with a 2020 School ICSEA value of 1000 or less. School ICSEA values are available on the Myschool website at myschool.edu.au.
7. The competition is open to all classes in eligible schools from years 4 to 6.

How to enter

8. Entry to Competition will open on Monday 23 August 2021 and close at midnight on Friday 10 September 2021 (“**Entry Period**”). Entries received outside of the Entry Period will not be accepted.
9. To enter, you must, during the Entry Period:
 - i) Fully complete the online entry form, including school name, teacher/principal name, teacher/principal email, teacher/principal contact number and class year level online at www.sparklab.qm.qld.gov.au.
 - ii) Submit a response in 100-words or less to the following question: Why is STEM important in your classroom?
10. Schools may enter multiple times for different classes or year levels by performing the activities listed in clause 10.
11. All entries become the property of the Promoter.

Judging

12. This promotion is a game of skill. Chance plays no part in determining the winners.

13. All valid entries will be judged individually on their merits. The entry that is judged to have the most creative merit will be the winner.
14. Judging will take place at 12:30pm on Tuesday 14 September 2021 at Queensland Museum, Corner Grey and Melbourne Streets, South Brisbane Qld 4101. Entries will be judged by a panel of judges from Queensland Museum and the Office of the Queensland Chief Scientist.
15. The Promoter may decline to accept any entry which, in its reasonable opinion, does not comply with these Terms and Conditions.
16. The Promoter's decision in relation to any aspect of the promotion is final and the Promoter will not enter into any correspondence regarding the result of the promotion.

Prize

17. Up to three Prizes are available, at the discretion of the judging panel.
18. Each winner will receive:
 - i.) A \$500 cash grant for transportation costs (payable after the visit has occurred);
 - ii.) Entry to *SparkLab*, Sciencentre at Queensland Museum;
 - iii.) Lunch and a tote bag for one class (up to 30 students and 10 chaperones)
 - iv.) Lunch with the Queensland Chief Scientist (where schedules allow)
19. The prize is valid for use on Wednesday 10 November or Friday 12 November 2021 as nominated on the entry form. These dates may be able to be changed at the discretion of the Promoter. Travel is to be arranged by the winner.
20. Any unused element of the prize remaining after 31 December 2021 will be forfeited.
21. Prizes are not transferable or refundable and cannot be taken as cash.
22. As a condition of accepting the Prize, the Prize winners (and any guests participating in using the Prize) must:
 - a. be available to redeem the Prize on the dates stipulated by the Promoter. If the Prize winner is not able to redeem the Prize in that date range, the Promoter may determine another Prize winner in its absolute discretion.
 - b. provide suitably qualified chaperones at the ratio of 1 adult to 5 students.
 - c. sign any legal documentation as and in the form required by the Promoter and/or Prize suppliers in their absolute discretion, including, but not limited to, photographic release.
 - d. comply with all the conditions of use of that Prize and the Prize supplier's requirements.
23. All Prizes are subject to availability. In the event that any of the Prizes or part of a Prize becomes unavailable due to circumstances beyond the Promoter's reasonable control, the Promoter reserves the right to provide a similar product to the same or greater value as the original prize, subject to any applicable laws or written directions made under applicable legislation.
24. The Prize does not include any of the following: travel insurance, personal spending money, applicable government taxes, levies, compliance with any health or other government requirements, and any other items not explicitly mentioned in the prize description.

Notification of winner/s

25. The winner/s will be contacted by phone or email using the phone number or email address provided on their entry form on or by week commencing Monday 13 September 2021. The winner's school, year level and response will be published on the *SparkLab*, Sciencentre website at www.sparklab.qm.qld.gov.au.

26. To claim the prize, the winner/s must have made contact with the Promoter (either by phone or by responding to the Promoter's email) by Friday 8 October 2021.
27. If the Promoter is unable to contact the winner/s by 8 October 2021, that winner will forfeit the Prize and the Prize may be awarded to the next best entry (as determined by the judges). The new winner will be contacted by phone or email using the phone number or email address provided on their entry form on or by 15 October 2021.
28. Confirmation of the Prize will be delivered to the winner/s via email within 14 days after the prize being claimed.
29. If any Prize becomes unavailable for any reason, the Promoter may substitute a Prize of equal or greater value.
30. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax implications that may arise for any Prize.

Intellectual property

31. You confirm and promise that your entry is original and does not infringe the intellectual property rights of any third party. You grant the Promoter an unrestricted, irrevocable, transferable right and licence to use and modify your entry including for promotional purposes without the payment of any further fee or compensation or further reference to you, and you agree that the Promoter can authorise other people to do any of these things. If requested by the Promoter, you agree to sign any further documentation required by the Promoter to give effect to this arrangement.
32. To the extent permitted by law, you unconditionally and irrevocably consent to the Promoter modifying your entry as described in this clause, agree that the Promoter is not required to attribute you as author of the entry, and consent to any other act or omission that would otherwise infringe any moral rights in your entry.

Withdrawal from promotion

If you withdraw from the promotion, the Promoter will remove your entry and will not use your details or entry for media or promotional purposes. If you withdraw from the promotion, you will no longer be eligible to win a prize.

Miscellaneous

34. Entries which, in the opinion of the Promoter, are incomplete, incorrect or incomprehensible, contain defamatory or offensive content or infringe intellectual property rights are not eligible to win and may be removed from the promotion and the relevant entrant will be disqualified.
35. The Promoter may, in its absolute discretion disqualify you if, in the opinion of the Promoter, you breach these Terms and Conditions, engage in dishonest or unethical conduct in relation to the promotion, manipulate, tamper or interfere with the conduct of the promotion, do not comply with the entry process, or conspire with others to gain an unfair advantage. The Promoter may audit you if it suspects you of having engaged in such breach or conduct.
36. The Promoter may request information from you relevant to entry or participation in the promotion, such as proof of residency. The Promoter may, in its absolute discretion, disqualify you if you provide insufficient information, false information or fail to provide information.
37. The Promoter is not responsible for any late, lost or misdirected entries.
38. The Promoter is not responsible for any delays, problems or technical malfunction of any, computer systems, computer equipment or software, technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any website, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to your or any other person's computer related to or resulting from entering this promotion. If such problems arise, then the Promoter may modify, cancel, terminate or suspend the promotion.

39. To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter is not be liable for any loss, damage or injury whatsoever (including, but not limited to, indirect or consequential loss) resulting from this promotion, including the taking of prizes.

If, for any reason, this promotion is not capable of running as planned, including pandemic, war, terrorism, state of emergency or disaster, infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of this promotion, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the promotion.
